Promises about Intimacy, Identity, and Inheritance in Every Book of the Bible

#### **Genesis:** My God is good and He is in control.

"Nothing is too difficult for the Lord...the Judge of the Earth will do what is right!" Gen. 18:14,24

#### **Exodus:** My God surrounds me and is abounding in love for me.

"The Lord, the Lord, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love & faithfulness, maintaining love to thousands, & forgiving wickedness, rebellion & sin." Ex. 34:6-7

#### **Leviticus:** My God is holy and He is making me holy.

'Consecrate yourselves and be holy, because I am the Lord your God. Keep my decrees and follow them. I am the Lord, who makes you holy." Lev. 20:7-8

#### **Numbers:** My God is presently blessing me and giving me peace.

"The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace." Num. 6:24-26

#### **Deuteronomy:** My God fights my battles. I only need to follow.

"Do not be afraid of them; the Lord your God himself will fight for you." Deut. 3:22

#### **Joshua:** My God is always with me, so courage is my inheritance.

"Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go" Joshua 1:9

**Judges:** My God comes to my rescue when I humble myself and call on Him. "The Lord raised up judges, who saved them out of the hand of those who plundered them." Judges 2:16

#### **Ruth:** My God is my Refuge and my Rewarder.

"May the Lord repay you for what you have done. May you be richly rewarded by the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge." Ruth 2:12

#### **<u>1 Samuel</u>**: My God is rewarding every place I choose to be faithful.

"The Lord rewards everyone for their righteousness and faithfulness." 1 Sam. 26:23

#### **<u>2 Samuel:</u>** My God is my heart's home forever.

"The Lord declares to you that the Lord himself will establish a house for you...and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever." 2 Sam. 7:11-13

#### **1 Kings:** My God has never failed to keep a promise...and He won't start now.

"Praise be to the Lord, who has given rest to his people Israel just as he promised. Not one word has failed of all the good promises he gave through his servant Moses." 1 Kgs 8:56

#### **<u>2 Kings:</u>** My God delivers me from the hand of every enemy.

"Worship the Lord your God; it is he who will deliver you from the hand of all your enemies." 2 Kgs 17:39

# **<u>1 Chronicles</u>**: My God has a history of faithfulness.

"Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the Lord rejoice. Look to the Lord & his strength; seek his face always. Remember the wonders he has done, his miracles, & the judgments he pronounced." 1 Chron. 16:10-12

#### **<u>2 Chronicles</u>**: My God is actively healing me every place I come to Him in humility.

"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves & pray & seek my face & turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin & will heal their land." 2 Chron. 7:14

**Ezra:** My God will never stop pursuing me with His love.

"With praise and thanksgiving they sang to the Lord: "He is good; his love toward Israel endures forever." Ezra 3:11

**Nehemiah:** My God waits to fill me with joy that is my victory. *"The joy of the Lord is your strength." Neh. 8:10* 

**Esther:** My God uniquely positioned me to partner with Him in restoration. *"Who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?" Esther 4:14* 

**Job:** My God is presently working wonders beyond my ability to comprehend. "Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful for me to know." Job 42:3

**Psalms:** My God is the delight of my heart and has fully given Himself to me. "Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart." Psalms 37:4

**Proverbs:** My God makes my paths straight as I trust Him. "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight." Prov. 3:5-6

**Ecclesiastes:** My God makes everything beautiful in its time and satisfies every eternal longing of my heart.

"He has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart." Eccl. 3:11

# **Song of Solomon:** I am my Beloved's and He is mine. Forever.

"I am my beloved's and my beloved is mine." Song of Solomon 6:3

**Isaiah:** My God loves to give me grace and rises up to be my justice.

"He Lord longs to be gracious to you; therefore he will rise up to show you compassion. For the Lord is a God of justice. Blessed are all who wait for him!" Is. 30:18

Jeremiah: My God is nurturing the seed of my heart to grow up as His child.

"I will build them up and not tear them down; I will plant them and not uproot them. I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the Lord. They will be my people, and I will be their God." Jer. 24:6-7

Lamentations: My God is the 'Morning of New Mercies' rising over every dark night of my soul.

"Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness...no one is cast off by the Lord forever. Though he brings grief, he will show compassion, so great is his unfailing love." Lam. 3:22-23,31-32

**Ezekiel:** My God redeems every dead place I've been & resurrects me into life with Him. "Then you, my people, will know that I am the Lord, when I open your graves and bring you up from them. I will put my Spirit in you and you will live, and I will settle you in your own land." Ez. 37:13-14

**Daniel:** My God rules over every season, every king, and every problem too difficult for me. "Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom & power are his. He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning. He reveals deep and hidden things; he knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with him." Dan. 2:20-22

**Hosea:** My God pursues me with justice, love, and compassion and has won my heart. "I will betroth you to me forever; I will betroth you in righteousness and justice, in love and compassion. I will betroth you in faithfulness, and you will acknowledge the Lord." Hosea 2:19-20

# Joel: My God is redeeming all that has been stolen and all that was lost.

"I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten...You will have plenty to eat, until you are full, & you will praise the name of the Lord your God, who has worked wonders for you; never again will my people be shamed." Joel 2:25-26

#### Amos: My God rules over the heights, yet draws near to the depths of my heart.

"He who forms the mountains, who creates the wind, and who reveals his thoughts to mankind, who turns dawn to darkness, and treads on the heights of the earth—the Lord God Almighty is his name." Amos 4:13

#### **Obadiah:** My God is just and will make every wrong right.

"The day of the Lord is near for all nations. As you have done, it will be done to you; your deeds will return upon your own head." Obadiah 1:15

# **Jonah:** My God has great compassion to rescue those destroying themselves through their own brokenness.

"Should I not have concern for the great city of Nineveh, in which there are more than a hundred & twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left—and also many animals?" Jonah 4:11

#### **Micah:** My God hurls my every iniquity into depths of the sea.

"Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy. You will again have compassion on us; you will tread our sins underfoot and hurl all our iniquities into the depths of the sea." Micah 7:18-19

#### **Nahum:** My God is the Peace who will end every injustice.

"Look, there on the mountains, the feet of one who brings good news, who proclaims peace! Celebrate your festivals, Judah, & fulfill your vows. No more will the wicked invade you; they will be completely destroyed." Nahum 1:15

#### Habbakkuk: My God cannot and will not commit any wrong against me.

"Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrongdoing." Habakkuk 1:13

#### **Zephaniah:** My God is presently rejoicing over me with singing.

"The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing." Zeph. 3:17

# **Haggai:** My God is producing glory & peace in the midst of the things shaking around me.

"This is what the Lord Almighty says: 'In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all nations, and what is desired by all nations will come, and I will fill this house with glory,' says the Lord Almighty...greater than the glory of the former house,' says the Lord Almighty. 'And in this place I will grant peace,' declares the Lord Almighty.." Haggai 2:6-9

#### **Zechariah:** My battles are not won by power or might, but by surrender to the Holy Spirit. *"Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit," says the Lord Almighty." Zech. 4:6*

# Malachi: My God is at work today, refining me to the purity of all He created me to be.

"He will be like a refiner's fire or a launderer's soap. He will sit as a refiner and purifier of silver; he will purify the Levites and refine them like gold and silver." Mal. 3:2-3

#### **Matthew:** My God is ready to take my burdens and to give me rest.

"Come to me, all you who are weary & burdened, & I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you & learn from me, for I am gentle & humble in heart, & you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy & my burden is light." Matt. 11:28-30

"Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy Spirit." Mk. 3:11

"But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." Lk. 2:10-11

# **John:** My God stands ready to fill me with Living Water in every place I thirst.

"On the last & greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood & said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me & drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them." Jn. 7:37-38

# Acts: My God fills me with power to live in victory & to lead those I encounter there too.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8

# **Romans:** I have peace with God today that allows me to stand in faith, grace, and glory — even in the midst of sufferings.

"Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance." Rom. 5:1-3

# **1 Corinthians:** My God is presently at work beyond my capacity to think or imagine.

"What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived" the things God has prepared for those who love him—these are the things God has revealed to us by his Spirit." 1 Cor. 2:9-10

"Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit." 2 Cor. 3:17-18

# **<u>Galatians</u>**: My God has already given me everything I need to respond in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. I do not need to achieve or strive for them. They are mine.

Eph. 3:17-19

# **Philippians:** My God will complete every good work He began in me.

"I am confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus." Php. 1:6

# **<u>Colossians</u>**: My God qualifies me to the full inheritance of the saints. I give joyful thanks.

"Giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light." Col. 1:12

**<u>1</u> Thessalonians:** My God is presently at work to bring my whole body, soul, and spirit to fullness and wholeness in Him. He will do it.

"May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through & through. May your whole spirit, soul & body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is faithful, & he will do it." 1 Thess. 5:23-24

**2 Thessalonians:** My God is faithful and strengthens and protects me from the evil one. *"The Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one." 2 Thess. 3:4* 

**1 Timothy:** My God saved me in my worst sin, & He delights to save me where I miss it still. "Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners—of whom I am the worst." 1 Tim. 1:15

# **1 John:** My God is presently lavishing me with a love that banishes every fear.

"There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love." 1 Jn. 4:18

# **<u>2 John</u>**: Everywhere I choose to obey God is a place I manifest love.

"And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love." 2 Jn. 1:6

# **<u>3 John</u>**: Every time I choose to bless those who can do nothing for me, many beyond them experience God's love.

" Dear friend, you are faithful in what you are doing for the brothers and sisters, even though they are strangers to you. They have told the church about your love." 3 Jn. 1:5-6
